The ultrasound on September 7, 2020 brought news of a healthy baby **BOY!**


We were in shock at first

COVID-19 UPDATE

Nassau, New Providence Locked Down

The congregation (and our island, Grand Bahama) has been blessed to be **<u>past</u>** the lockdowns but the capital city, Nassau on the island New Providence has been subjected to a series of them in recent weeks due to Community Spread on that island. We have had free movement over the past two months since the last report and hope the same will continue throughout the rest of 2020 on our island. Since Hurricane Dorian, there has been no fully functioning hospital here on Grand Bahama and a surge in cases would be difficult for the Hospital's Authority to manage. The government is currently renting portions of private facilities to host the various wards for admitted patients. We must remain prayerful that things continue to improve in regard to island-wide health.

A study has come to a sad end.

It was with a Catholic young lady who said upon comparing her church to the church of the Bible, that she will have to answer God for herself on why she partook in something that was starkly different from what she read of in the New Testament. Soon after the end of her study, the Pope released the statement
