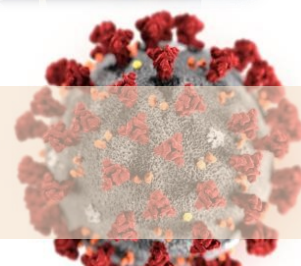


2021 Ladies Class Goal Planning
