APOLOGETICS SERIES


Historically, the Bahamas was a Christian nation. Even now, there is a national "Christian Council" who makes decisions on certain matters and is consulted by political officials. There is nonetheless, an increasing number of atheists or otherwise reli-

giously confused individuals throughout the country as more people complete university abroad and have less interest in religion in general. As a result, sermons on Sunday mornings (also on Facebook Live) have been on Apologetics topics surrounding God, Bible Contradictions, the Bible Bang, Evidence for Our Faith etc.

THE MEN PROGRESS

Since we started the work, having a limited number of men has been difficult. Studies and conversions are heavily female and of the few men that have converted, only three have remained faithful. It was mentioned that the Smith family was at one point having great difficulty in their marriage, but made a 180 degree turn. In the past year they have been consistent and faithful. The husband started teaching Bible class (under my watchful eye) a few months ago and is currently giving an overview of each book in the Bible. He has been growing immensely as a Christian and leader.

We celebrated 16 years of marriage in March and spent a few days alone with one child (a substantial break when there are five children).
