This is Santhoshi Amma (her name means - happy mother). She is leper older lady and begs every day. Some of her fingers are gone because of the disease. She begs at railway station. She lives in our leper colony. She got baptised last year. Few months ago a Hindu guru who makes a lots of anti-Christian videos wanted to show his viewers how Christians bribe others with money and things to get converted to Christianity. He was in the railway station and went to our Santhosh Amma and said I will give you Rs. 100 (little over a dollar) and asked "are you a Christian". She looked up to him and said "yes I am a Christian and follow Jesus Christ". He said, "I will give you Rs. 100, will you leave Christ and take this money?". She said "no I will not". He said, "I will give you Rs. 200 and more if you leave Christ and come to our god". She can't read, she is a leper, she is an old lady who has faith in Christ. She said

"no, I will not leave Christ even when you give me lots of money.

Jesus Christ is my God". He tried to persuade her but he could not. In the end he said "well, you are old, a leper and a beggar. I will give you this Rs. 100 anyways. What will you do with this money?". She replied, "this Sunday when I go to church, I will put this in the offering and will pray for you".

<u>Picture to the left</u>— This is a gospel meeting in a village called Kotha pallie. In India there is a lot of

Christ". I got to speak for two hours about "Jesus being God". There were few preachers present in this gospel meeting that

Christ in those villages. These preachers are trained in our School of Preaching and are very solid in the word of God.


One of the churches has requested for sound boxes for their churches. To the left are those be-

Picture to the Left — The books in this picture are "Voice of Truth International" in Telugu Language. These books go out to many places from our office. We also have a bible course where we get over 200 request per day. We right now have twelve in our office staff who takes care of this. Once someone finishes our Bible course we give them a free Telugu or Oriya Bible via post. This year we are running \$1200 short per month for our bibles because of Covid and various other reasons few churches have dropped out.



Picture on the Left — Many have been affected with Corona virus. Some of the brethren are gracious to send help to give it to those who need help. We try to help those who are in need with groceries. Every month we help 75 of the older women who needed help with

the groceries. Not everyone is in this picture. This month, one church from US contacted and wanted to give "sanitary pads" to our women of the church, and distributed 100 of them to young Christians ladies. This have had a good response.



<u>Picture to the Right</u> - I am also authorized to do wedding in India. We need to have a license from the government to do weddings. I was privileged to officiate a wedding of Arun Raj and Venkatalakshmi. Arun was one of our Children Home kids. He was with us for more then 5 years. Later he finished his engineering. He also is a body builder and won many of the competitions. He used to work in the local gym but now is a personal trainer.

Missions Request

- ⇒ Because of Covid, few of our supporting churches has stopped and reduced their budget. Please do consider in helping us little more in your missions budget for the next year. Each Bible is now \$3 in Telugu and Oriya language. We get hundreds of requests for our Bible courses and for our Bibles. This coming year we are *short of \$1200 per month for Bibles*. Every little dollar is a great help for our Bibles.
- \Rightarrow We need \$2500 for a water well in one of the villages we work with.
- \Rightarrow We need \$6000 to help construct a church building near Narisipatnam village.
