It was a challenge for us to conduct our L2L this year. We were scheduled to have four conventions this year but the government did not give permissions for two because of Covid. We were ready to start

a new one this year but we postponed it. Because we do not know when things would come back to normal. We had two conventions, one in "Narisipatnam" and another one in "Chintapalli". These two are in

"Telugu" language. Our "Tamil" language convention got canceled because government did not give us permissions.

they could do mighty things for God. We have had 11 churches come together this year in a village called "B.K. Palli". We had different competi-

tions like Bible Quiz in the Book of Acts, reciting Bible verses, speech

> and songs.

We had our annual L2L, India convention in "Chintapalli", Andhra Pradesh. We had 23 churches who participated in two days. We had about 500 who participated this year. These are tribal area churches and they have their own language in their villages. It is very neat to hear them sing in their own native language We had a Bible Quiz in the

book of Acts, Bible memory verses recital, Speech and group singing.

Everyone who comes to our L2L gets few prizes to take with them and we feed them meals so that they do not have to go somewhere for food. We also provide them a place to stay for the night. We usually have these for two days a year. We usually give away many prizes. Few of the first prizes include: an ipad and a few smart phones. We also had trophies to the congregations who excelled in different categories. Everyone who comes gets a free L2L T-Shirt and

many school supplies. This year "Kalapari" Church of Christ won prize for "over all"

achievement for L2L. Brother Alexander Campbell is the man behind the success of this area. Every day for two days they feed 1000 tribal people.

<u>Picture to the left</u>— My mother Kabita Gootam has been working with "Oriya" language in the state of Orissa. We got to go and spend time

with Mr. Patnaiak in Navrangpur, Orissa in the month of December. He is the one who prints our work in Oriya language. Every month we send the 3500 copies to that many homes in the state of Orissa and when she started, 28 years ago there was not even one

Church of Christ there in that state. The churches in Orissa get printed materials from us. Printed materials last long and people can go back and read them again and again. She has been instrumental in providing

books and materials for the Churches of Christ in Orissa state all these years. The next generation of the Church needed to be trained to stay faithful and evangelize on

our own. We also run Bible Correspondence course and 75,000 are involved and each one get a free bible when they finish.

We had Brother Tim Wilks from Memphis, TN visiting us. He was with us for two

weeks. He taught "Fishers of men"

last time when he was with us and this year he was supposed to be one of our speakers at all our L2L events but when he got off the plane on Jan 5th, he was coughing and had cold and he was sick. After few days he got better and was able to do few things with us here in Kakinada. We could not do all what he was supposed to do but he preached to us and was

about to speak at one other place addressing the youth. We hope to have more visitors from US this year and work with them in some of

the villages. The Indian government has been very hard on our "Mission work" but God always provided.

Everyone who finish our bible course in Telugu or in Oriya will get a free bible and a certificate from us. Every bible which goes from us has written on it that it is from us. In Telugu language there is only one translation which is directly from "Greek, Hebrew and Aramic" languages. Every month we reach 2400 new souls for Christ.
