We hope you are good health and are met with many opportunities to seek the lost and do good this year!

January has been good for the work here. The congregation, although small, has split off into three groups to accomplish the tasks of:

- 1) completing the new building;
- 2) getting the Community Garden ready for a few fruit trees and animals; and
- 3) reaching people through clothing drives every other Saturday.

We have been encouraging younger members (newer Christians) to remain faithful and studying with those who have agreed. So many have been inconsistent in consecutively studying that it has been taking longer than the ideal time to complete. Naturally, this is not affected the efforts to carryout those studies as this is the chief task of the work here!

I have started offering marriage counselling, as a means to open the door for studies and in those sessions, heavily teach the Word of God. We may offer the sessions more actively.

We meet in person for worship but the congregation has ALSO been getting on Zoom at 5:30 a.m. for fifteen minutes to go through a Psalm on Mondays and Acts in preparation for Sunday Bible Class, on Wednesdays and Fridays. This has been encouraging!

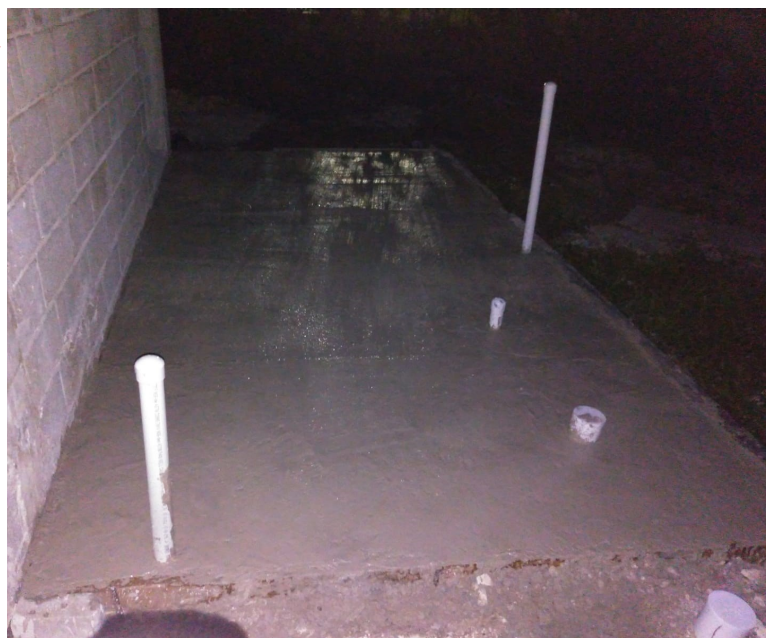

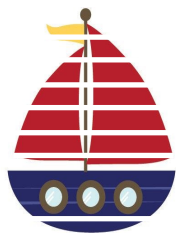
