On about three occasions before summer, we had visits from a lady who lived near to one of the members. She was very sweet and in September **she asked to be baptized**. As always, we talked a bit before heading to the ocean and I quickly realized there were some things that were not understood, so we agreed to study further. This lady shared her story and it was heartbreaking.

Twenty years ago, she was married to a man who turned out to be a drug addict. Naturally, although there was no adultery, she left him. In time— as expected without knowing God's law— she met someone new and started dating him. Throughout the course of studying, she realized something had to change and initially talked about trying to finalize the divorce so that she and the current partner could marry. However, when she realized what Matthew 19 teaches **she wept**. She and her partner share an apartment, four children and he provides. One of the children is autistic and needs her full attention, so she does not work.

The truth is, it's hard to sacrifice so many known things for the unknown. She became discouraged. She mentioned to her partner, the need to leave the relationship and change her life, but she is afraid. She is not sure how she would survive without him and his help. Trusting God is just too difficult when there is no understanding of His power and the value of heaven. Getting her to see spiritually with a carnal mind is challenging at best.

Please pray that she will have COURAGE to do the hard things and reconvene studies so that she can increase in FAITH.
