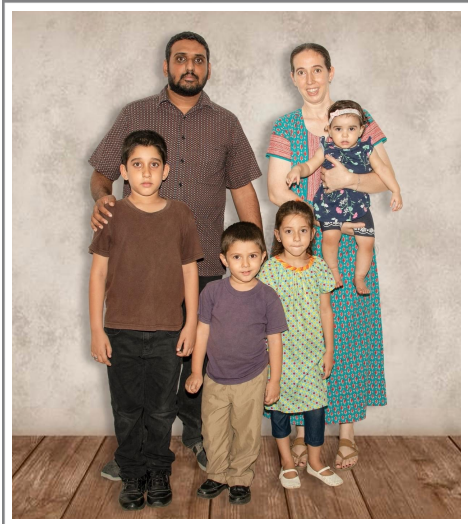


# Mission Report for April 2023
